

LABOUR MARKET BRIEF ■ ATLANTIC REGION



- Employment grew at a strong pace in September, up from the prior month by 157,100 jobs, making it the fourth consecutive monthly gain.
- Full-time jobs increased alongside fewer part-time.
- The unemployment rate fell in the month to 6.9%, reaching its lowest point since February 2020.
- The goods-producing sector added jobs (+14,700), while the services-producing sector saw growth of 142,400 jobs.
- Employment grew at a strong pace in September, up from the prior month by 7,300 jobs, making it the fourth consecutive monthly gain.
- Full-time jobs increased alongside fewer part-time.
- ★ The unemployment rate moved higher in the month to 9.7%.
- The goods-producing sector lost jobs in September (-2,600), while the services-producing sector saw growth of 10,000 jobs.


